SUMMARY

Established in 2000, Helping Hands of Vegas Valley is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that provides assistive services to senior citizens in Southern Nevada, allowing them to maintain their dignity and independence while improving daily living. Helping Hands provides transportation to and from medical appointments, shopping trips and errands; telephone reassurance and friendly visits. The organization also administers a respite care voucher program and maintains a food pantry. More information about Helping Hands of Vegas Valley can be found at www.hhovv.org.

The transportation program provides seniors with wheel chair accessible buses and volunteer transportation free of charge. Services include, escorted transportation for medical appointments, transportation to and from the supermarket or drug store, bank, and other needed destinations.

Helping Hands of Vegas Valley maintains a food pantry with nonperishable foods. Eligible seniors receive a 20 lb bag of free groceries from the pantry one time per month. These goods are typically provided through food donations and food drives from local companies or groups, as well as purchased from Three Square. The food is delivered to the seniors by dedicated volunteers.

The Respite Care program is funded by the NV Aging & Disabled Services Division and administered by Helping Hands of Vegas Valley to provide financial assistance for respite care services throughout Southern Nevada. Essentially, this service provides temporary relief for the caregiver so they can provide the care needed for the recipient (senior). It allows the caregiver to take time off to avoid “burning out”. It is a way to reduce a caregiver’s stress so they can be more effective.

We are dedicated to providing every possible support and assistance to at risk seniors in our community. Please join us in this effort to help our community’s seniors.
